**(Pursuant to Section 506 and 1526 of the Real Property Tax Law)**  
**HEARING OF COMPLAINTS**

Notice is hereby given that as of May 1, 2020, the Assessor of the Town of New Berlin, County of Chenango, has completed the Tentative Assessment Roll for the current year, and that a copy has been filed at Town Hall. An online copy of the Tentative Assessment Roll will be available for viewing at the Town of New Berlin website <https://www.townofnewberlin.org/> and at the Chenango County website <http://www.co.chenango.ny.us/real-property-tax/rolls.php> per requirement of RPTL section 1590.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions an in-person viewing of the Roll may not be possible. The Assessor will be in attendance with the Tentative Assessment Roll **BY PHONE ONLY** at 607-847-8909 on the following days:

Contact the Assessor or Town Clerk or with any questions regarding Grievance Day. Please note: it is not necessary to appear in person to have the Board of Assessment Review review and rule on your complaint. Grievances may be emailed, mailed in to or dropped off at Town of New Berlin Town Hall, 30 North Main Street, PO Box 845, New Berlin, NY. 13411. Phone conferences and calls will be available on Grievance Day. All grievances paperwork should contain clear contact information and a method in which the grievant would like the review to be handled. If no method is requested or if three tries to contact the grievant fail, then the mail in form and attachments will be the evidence used to review and rule on your grievance. Anyone with a hardship to adhere to the grievant methods should contact the Town Clerk or Assessor.

The Board of Assessment Review will meet on Tuesday May 26, 2020 at 4 pm - 6 pm and 7 pm – 9 pm to hear and examine all complaints in relation to assessments on the application of any persons believing him/herself to be aggrieved.
